Entries

- Dogs must be at least 6 months of age to compete.
- Notice: All dogs present are required to have current vaccinations for rabies.
- Any dog exhibiting symptoms of disease will be asked to leave the trial grounds. All dogs present must be held on a leash or confined to a crate at all times. Bring water and food for your dog.)
- Bitches in season may participate in accordance with Chapter 2, Section 8 of the AKC Tracking Regulations.
- Declination of entries: The Burlington County Kennel Club, Inc may decline any entry for cause and may refuse to receive or remove on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause and no one shall have any claim or recourse against The Burlington County Kennel Club, Inc. or any official thereof.

- Telegraph, telephone and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on Official AKC entry forms or photocopies of those forms and without agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official form are not acceptable.
- A recording fee of \$.50 and a \$3.00 AKC event service fee will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking test. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions to its acceptance.
- Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event the dog is absent, disqualified, or excused by Judge or Veterinarian or barred from competition by action of the Test Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or complete the test, no refund of entry fees will be made.
- Section 17d Test Worker Option. A club may set aside tracks for test workers from previous tests, as defined and identified by the test giving club. This information and the number of tracks to be set aside must be published in the premium list. Entries from workers are to be drawn first, up to the limits shown in the table below. Once the tracks set aside for workers are filled, any remaining test worker entries will be added to the non-worker entries for the draw of the remaining tracks. There will be no separate alternate list for test workers only. A test worker may not benefit from a track set aside at a test in which they are working. Deviations from the table are not permitted for any test, combined test or multiple tests.

The TDX test limited to 3 entries. A drawing will be held immediately following the close of entries, at the Secretary's home, to determine which entries will be accepted. Preference will be given to dogs that have not previously earned the TDX title. When the Trial limit has been reached, any remaining entries, subject to the same preference, shall be drawn for a position on the alternate list.

(Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- 2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- 3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e, age division, color division, weight division.
- 4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether then ew owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
- 5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
